Another good month with an overall increase of passenger numbers of nearly 5%, with International numbers up by 7.6% and domestic down by 13.6%. Surprisingly scheduled movements were down 8.78% and charter down by 3.69%.

This month saw 53 different international routes operated, the top three all being Spanish those being Palma, Alicante, and Malaga followed by Amsterdam and then Dublin. 27 routes had an increase with the best being Fuerteventura (+238%), followed by Bodrum (+112%), Arrecife (+74%), Barcelona (+69%) and Venice (+62%). The worst performing were Geneva (-33%), Naples (-32%) and Rhodes (-30%) with 22 routes overall showing a decrease.

The only domestic routes to show an increase were Plymouth (+558%), Newquay (+156%) and Belfast City (+28%). The Isle of Man route reduced by 81% to just 101 passengers

Three flights diverted elsewhere and went to East Midlands, Manchester and Southampton!
