

Air Yorkshire Code of Conduct

- A member should not commit any act which would bring the society into disrepute in any way.
- A member should not attempt to gain access to airfields, parts of airfields or aviation related premises without the permission of the owner or administrator.
- A member should not enter or interfere with any airfield installation or aircraft without the knowledge and permission of the owner.
- A member should not purport to be acting on behalf of Air Yorkshire without having obtained the permission of the society's Committee or the delegated member responsible for that field of activity.
- A member should not attempt to acquire or disseminate information which s/he knows is subject to military or industrial security restrictions.
- A member should not commit any act in any country which would contravene the laws of that country or bring into jeopardy any members of Air Yorkshire resident or visiting there.
- A member should not pass on any information about the Society which could be of commercial value to other bodies to the detriment of Air Yorkshire.
- A member should not abuse the advantages of Air Yorkshire membership.
- The Committee of Air Yorkshire will be the sole judges of the application of this Code of Conduct.
