### Interesting facts

In 2012 LBIA was the **9<sup>th</sup> fastest growing airport in UK (+1.08%)** and was the UK's 16<sup>th</sup> busiest airport with **2,968,700** passengers.

Five years ago LBIA was also the 15<sup>th</sup> busiest airport.

In 2012 Charter Passengers were 5.47% of the total passengers. In 2011 it was 6.4%.

Aircraft Movements dropped 8.18% compared to 2011 and was the lowest figure in the last 10 years

There was a decrease in passenger movements of 8.6% in 2012 compared to 2011. The figure for 2012 was 30223

There were 75 diversions (102 in 2011) away from LBIA. Manchester received 47 followed by Liverpool (7), Doncaster (7), East Midlands (6) and others (8). LBIA also received 5 diversions (8 in 2011) from other airports. Only London City had more diversions (229) than LBIA. The next airports were Gatwick (75), Bristol (74) and then Manchester (69)

There were 294,450 Domestic and 2,673,700 International Passengers. The domestic passengers reduced by 13.9% compared to 2011 and International increased by 3.0%

In 2012 there were flights to 78 different international destinations, compared to 71 in 2011. Malaga (1<sup>st</sup> time) was the most popular followed by Amsterdam, Alicante, Palma, Dublin, Faro and Tenerife.

In 2012 there were 13 different domestic destinations, with the most popular being Belfast City followed by Southampton, Belfast International, Jersey, Glasgow and Bristol.

The freight figure for 2012 was 282 Tonnes, Up 45% when compared to 2011.
